Item 26.0	Opening remarks by Chairman Senate
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- Director happily informed about the Convocation 2022 after more than 5.5 years. It is to be held on 1st November 2022 at 10 am. All the senators are requested to take part in academic procession.

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- Six dean positions (DOAA, DOFA, DORC, DODP, DOSA, DOEAR) have been created. The appointments of 4 Deans are done. Two deans (DOAA, DOAER) were given addition charges of DOFA and DODP, respectively. Allocations of Deans' offices are also done
- Branch Change option after 1st year result from 2022-23 batch students is approved by BoG.
- Registration and travel support up to Rs 10,000/ to BTech/MTech/IPG/MBA students, once in complete program, for attending the conferences is approved by Board.
- To increase the research of Institute, good research oriented MTech students are given option to convert the MTech to PhD program.
- There is a plan for opening of new BTech and MTech programs subject to availability of residential accommodation.
- Planned two-day event on Atal Research and Incubation Conclave during Dec 9-10, 2022.
- Two IEEE International Conferences are planed: first during 18-20 November 2022 and second during 21-23 December 2022 at ABV-IIITM Gwalior.
- Various academic reforms are planned and will be presented in the next senate meeting.
- The institute has signed the MoU with Shraman Foundation, Plano for award of Scholarship of Rs 50000/- to 30 students for the financial support towards tuition, hostel, mess and/or any institutional fees to the undergraduate students of B Tech. The scholarship will commence form academic year 2022-23.
- The Institute has signed an MoU with Rajmata Vijay Raje Schindia Krishi Vishvidhalaya, Gwalior for academic and research activities and second for Agribusiness & Smart Village Incubation center.

Item 26.7	Removal of requirement of minimum 5.0 CGPA in allocation of thesis supervisor, award of degree, etc.
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It is found that students are completing the credit requirements as per rules, but some students having CGPA less than 5.0 are not able to get any degree. Therefore, it is proposed to discontinue with the minimum CGPA of 5.0 for BTech/IPG (IMT and IMG) students in award of degree, allocation of thesis supervisor, etc.
